

Town Of Independence
 Regular Meeting
 June 20, 2019

The Independence Town Board met in the Town Hall on June 20th, 2019 at 7:00 pm for the regular monthly meeting.

Present: Supervisor Reichman; Council: Waters, Acomb, Meunier; Town Clerk, Cindy Welch; Deputy Town Clerk, Jasmine Bledsoe. Absent: Council Howe, Highway Superintendent, Dennis Graves
 No visitors.

Supervisor Reichman called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was given.

A motion was made by Supervisor Reichman to approve the May 9th, 2019 minutes seconded by Council Acomb and carried by all.

Discussion was held concerning the Little League Field and the playground equipment/area. A motion to pursue purchasing property to straighten out the east/west line near the water building was made by Supervisor Reichman and seconded by Council Waters and approved by all.

Supervisor Reichman reported the Independence Cemetery people are working on holding a public meeting and forming a board. Report to follow.

Discussion was held concerning Assessor Lou Anne Glass's term, which will expire October 1st, 2019 and that she is not seeking re-appointment. The clerk presented board members with two resumes already received. Motion was made by Supervisor Reichman seconded by Council Acomb to advertise the position. Approved by all. Report to follow

Residents Steve and Kay Nagy submitted a letter requesting assistance with debris in the creek next to their house. The clerk reported she had already notified Highway Superintendent Graves and he had notified the DOT. Report to follow.

At this time (7:20 pm) Highway Superintendent Graves arrived and gave the Highway report.

Work report: Graveled Grantier Road, mowing roadsides, working dirt roads, reinforcing creek bank on Heselton, changed sluice pipes on Heselton and Nye roads, working bad storm drains in town.

Equipment report: finished spring servicing of equipment and trucks, replaced fuel pump on the 2016 International, brake repairs on the 2010 Kentworth and installed rubber track pads on the excavator.
